Strange price movements raise concerns about the high-frequency trading, technical glitches, fat finger errors and algorithms in today's computer-driven marketplace. **Steve Chalmers**, who spent a decade trading equities at a large brokerage firm and five years on NASDAQ's market intelligence desk as trading analyst, will explain what's currently happening in the stock markets, what's down the road, and how it impacts investor relations.
